Resident Teachers maintain a professional demeanor in all actions and communication with colleagues, parents, and students.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Willingness to work in a collaborative and team environment
- Dedication to professional development workshops and classes
- Plan, deliver, and amend as necessary the instructional programs and learning activities to ensure student success
- Participate fully in the life of the school by supporting school events, development efforts, and school programs.
