Hamlin Robinson School is the only non-profit school in the state of WA dedicated to serving students with dyslexia and other language-based learning differences. HRS serves 280 students in grades 1-8, who commute from four WA counties to access our programs. With proper diagnosis, appropriate instruction, hard work, and support, individuals with dyslexia can be very successful in school and in the workplace. HRS changes the lives and futures of our students and their families.

Some special things about Hamlin Robinson School:

- HRS is the only school in WA that offers a full elementary and middle school program using a multi-sensory approach for reading, writing, and spelling;
- The award winning HRS Learning Center provides resources for students and families, regardless of whether or not they are enrolled at our school. Programs include tutoring, parent and teacher workshops, and a speaker series for the general public.

Every year, HRS holds an auction to support operating expenses and make the school more accessible to students who need it.
